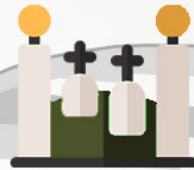

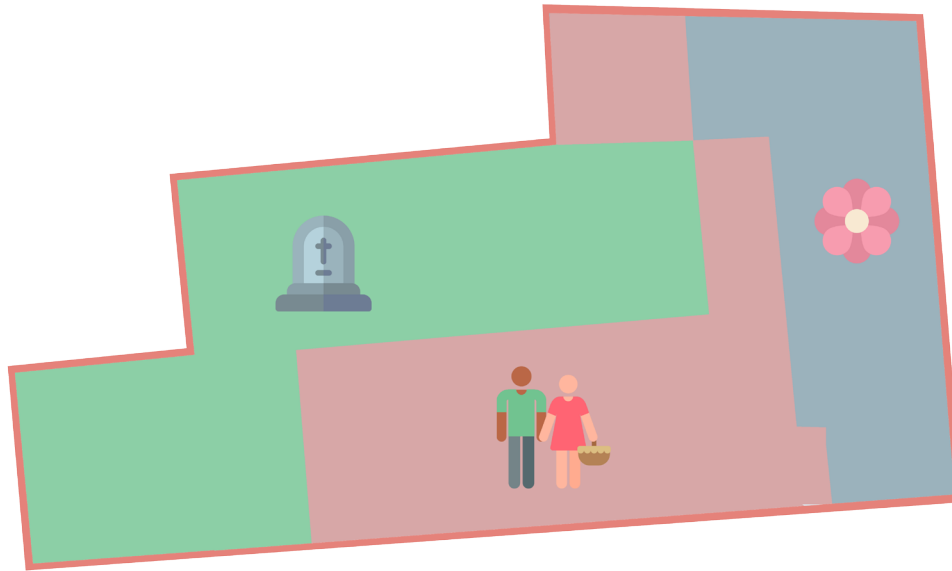

NURSERY

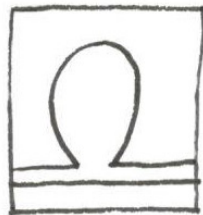
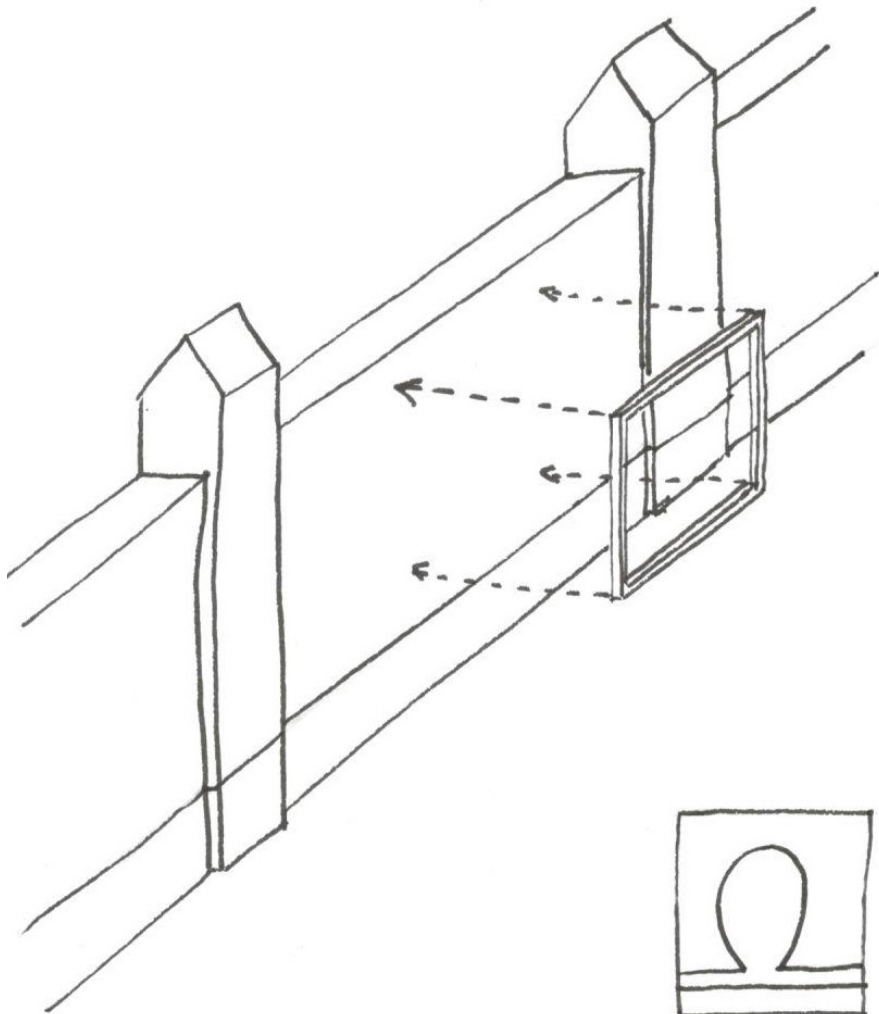
The nursery space is separated by a fence and is used in the same way as nowadays.

MEMORY PATH

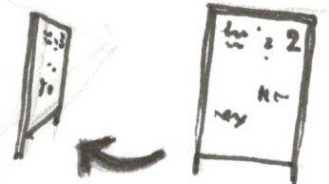
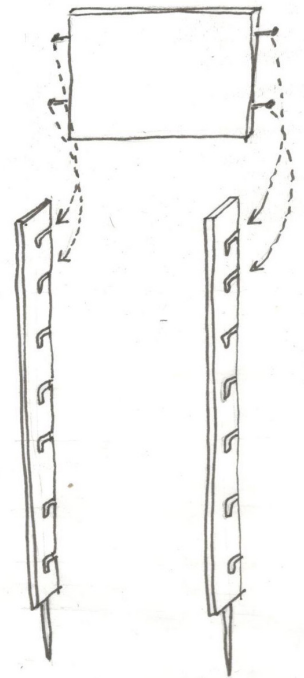

COMMUNITY SPACE

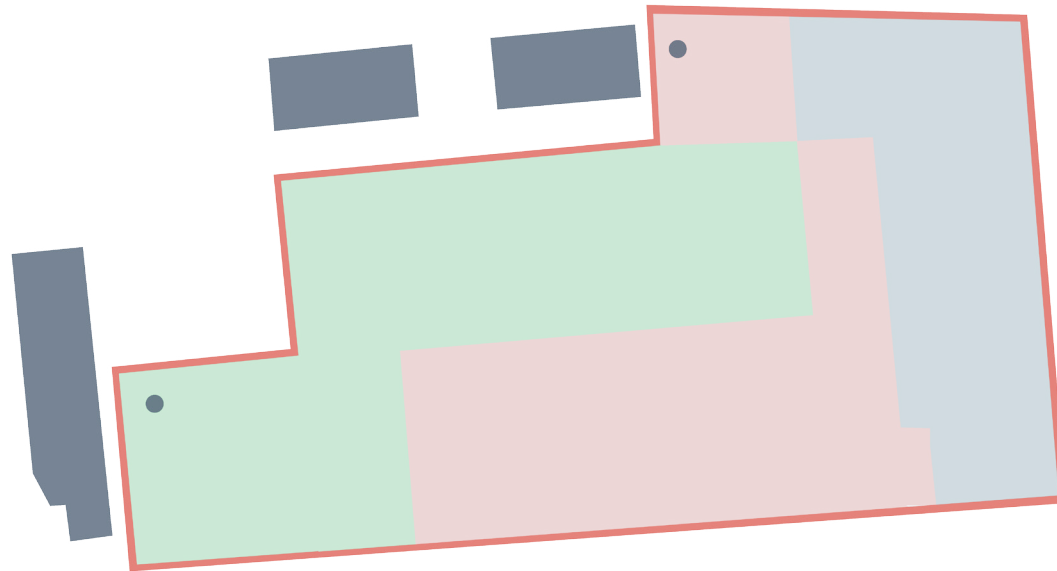

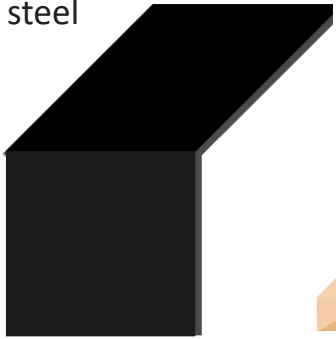


WATER MANAGEMENT

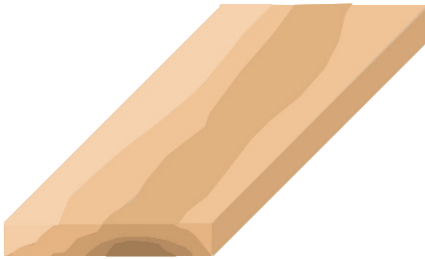

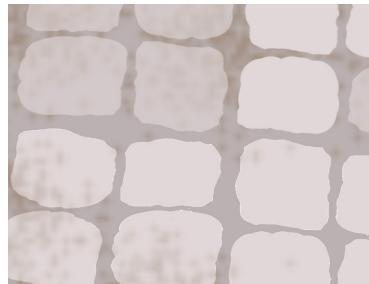

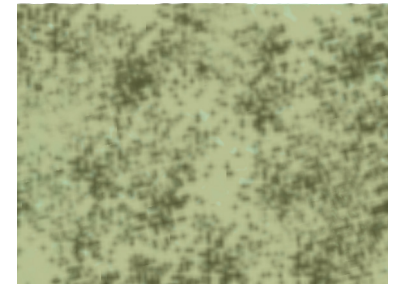
