II. EVALUATION OF INDIVIDUAL CRITERIA

Assignment challenging

How demanding was the assigned project?

Adaptive reuse of Strahov stadium is challenging because of the unique quality of the Strahov stadium itself. It is optimized for a one-of-a-kind event; and when this event stopped being performed, the stadium basically lost its meaning. Due to this uniqueness, it is also a historical landmark of considerable importance for Prague. Therefore any intervention must start from the extraordinary conditions of the stadium itself. It however escapes any typological precedent that can be used for easy reference.

Fulfilment of assignment

How well does the thesis fulfil the assigned task? Have the primary goals been achieved? Which assigned tasks have been incompletely covered, and which parts of the thesis are overextended? Justify your answer.

Ronit Doshi came up with the idea to bring multiple sports back to Strahov through a center of high-performance athletes. This is a conceptual project rather than an assignment based on a real client. Ronit Doshi aimed to push this idea as far as possible, while still respecting certain architectural boundaries.

Activity and independence when creating final thesis

Ronit Doshi is capable to work independently. He has good capability to work out plans systematically with consideration to organization, layout, and details.

The "surface" part of the project is well-conceived. Not only does it feature sports facilities for high-level athletes, but Ronit Doshi also gave ample space for leisure and amateur sports. This will make the concept much more accessible for the general audience and thus bring more life into the complex than a design purely focused on high-level activities and training. The "underground" part is more speculative and is less supported with structural and building-construction considerations.

Formal level and language level, scope of thesis

Ronit Doshi has analysed a number of realized high-performance training centres to understand the typology. The analysis is thorough and well-documented. As with most diploma theses these days, all the resources are taken from the Internet and not from journals or books.

Comment on the overall quality of the thesis, its novelty and its impact on the field, its strengths and weaknesses, the utility of the solution that is presented, the theoretical/formal level, the student's skillfulness, etc.

Ronit Doshi's proposal reinterprets Strahov stadium to give it back the plurality of sports activities for which it was actually created. The combination of high-level athletes training and amateur-recreational sports facilities put Strahov back again in the community of Prague. The surrounding master plan of the plaza tries to make this link more realizable. This work must be seen as a speculative contribution to the question what can be done with the unique facility that Strahov is.

With his diploma work, Ronit Doshi examines in an architectural way new options for the use of Strahov stadium. Although the program is largely speculative, the diploma work convincingly shows that a more pluralistic and sports integrated approach is possible.
