



## Campus pot

My intension was to create a playful place to rest from everyday duties, a place within the campus that would be actually very different from everything we see in the campus, a place that would maybe take you to your childhood.

I was inspired by iconic playgrounds that were created in 60' in Czechoslovakia as a part of Prague's BABA- a villa colony of functionalistic architecture constructed in early 30'. The construction would be made from metal bars tighten by metal strings. This arrangement creates many potential spaces to put a net in between which creates a place to rest. In order to get into the pot you would need to climb and there are many ways to get in, either to climb a ladder or climb the bars as climbing the tree or to jump up and to pull yourself up.

Once you climb up and make yourself comfortable, you could just watch the textile flying above your head. My intension was to evoke this theatrical and emotional feeling to the whole structure. This pot was designed for people to relax and to perceive the surroundings. Lately I caught myself looking from the window, but I was actually watching the curtains and there is nothing wrong with just watching the curtains. In my opinion, it is important sometimes to just switch off and to do nothing and with this message in mind I was designing this pot.
