Conditions for the granting of merit scholarships at the Faculty of Architecture ČVUT for the academic year 2018/2019

Dean's Decree No. 2/2019

This Decree is in accordance with the Scholarship Rules of CTU in Prague, dated February 22, 2018 as amended.

A merit scholarship may only be awarded to a student who, in the semester or academic year in which the right to a merit scholarship arises, that is, in the Academic Year 2019/20:

- a) is a student of CTU pursuant to § 61 of the Universities Act, as amended,
- b) studies in the standard period of study, or studies in the standard period of study extended by one year at most, if the student has studied for at least one semester at a foreign university within the framework of programs co-organized by CTU and submits a written request for a scholarship,
- c) has fulfilled the prescribed criteria for the granting of a scholarship.

The decisive section for payment of a merit scholarship is the academic year (both semesters of the Academic Year 2018/2019).

A student is entitled to a merit scholarship for excellent academic performance if, in the relevant section for which the scholarship is awarded:

- a) the student has earned at least 60 credits in completed subjects,
- b) the student took 8 or more classified subjects in the academic year,
- c) the student had a weighted study average of less than or equal to 1.50 for the academic year,
- d) studied through attendance study and in a standard period of study

(2 years – masters'study programs).

Students will submit their application by October 15, 2019 to Miss Kristýna Lindovská MA, room no. 147, on the ground floor.

The scholarship will be paid out on a one-time basis for 10 months. The merit scholarship is paid via cashless payment in Czech crowns.
