## FA MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

## Conditions for the granting of merit scholarships at the Faculty of Architecture (FA) of the Czech Technical University (CTU). Dean's Decree no. 4/2020.

The Decree is in conformity with Act No. 111/1998 Sb., On Universities, § 91, para. (3) letter. (b) of this Act, and in accordance with CTU Scholarship Regulations of 1 September 2019.

- 1. A merit scholarship may only be awarded to a student who, in the semester or academic year in which the right to a merit scholarship arises:
  - a) is a student of CTU pursuant to § 61 of the Universities Act, as amended,
  - b) studies in the standard period of study, or studies in the standard period of study extended by one year at most, if the student has studied for at least one semester at a foreign university within the framework of programs co-organized by CTU and submits a written request for a scholarship,
  - c) has fulfilled the prescribed criteria for the granting of a scholarship.
- 2. The decisive section for payment of a merit scholarship is the preceding academic year (both semesters).
- 3. A student is entitled to a merit scholarship for excellent academic performance if, in the relevant section for which the scholarship is awarded:
  - a) the student has earned at least 60 credits in completed subjects,
  - b) the student took 8 or more classified subjects in the academic year,
  - c) the student had a weighted study average of less than or equal to 1.50 for the academic vear,
  - d) studied through attendance study and in a standard period of study (2 years masters' study programs).
- 4. Students will submit their application by October 16 to Ms. Kristýna Sedlaříková MA, room no. 147, ground floor.
- 5. The scholarship will be paid out on a one-time basis for 10 months. The scholarship is paid non-cash in CZK to the student s Czech bank account number, registered in the CTU KOS system.
